Persons of Hispanic origin represent 11.6% of the population in the identified area compared to 17.9% of the U.S. population. Persons of Hispanic Origin may be of any race. The Diversity Index, which measures the probability that two people from the same area will be from different race/ethnic groups, is 40.6 in the identified area, compared to 63.5 for the U.S. as a whole.

Current median household income is \$80,593 in the area, compared to \$54,149 for all U.S. households. Median household income is projected to be \$90,307 in five years, compared to \$59,476 for all U.S. households

Current average household income is \$100,617 in this area, compared to \$77,008 for all U.S. households. Average household income is projected to be \$109,829 in five years, compared to \$84,021 for all U.S. households

Current per capita income is \$40,262 in the area, compared to the U.S. per capita income of \$29,472. The per capita income is projected to be \$44,129 in five years, compared to \$32,025 for all U.S. households

Currently, 64.6% of the 49,399 housing units in the area are owner occupied; 31.5%, renter occupied; and 3.9% are vacant. Currently, in the U.S., 55.4% of the housing units in the area are owner occupied; 32.9% are renter occupied; and 11.7% are vacant. In 2010, there were 46,067 housing units in the area - 67.4% owner occupied, 28.4% renter occupied, and 4.2% vacant. The annual rate of change in housing units since 2010 is 3.15%. Median home value in the area is \$321,508, compared to a median home value of \$198,891 for the U.S. In five years, median value is projected to change by 2.48% annually to \$363,486.
