Xcel Energy plans to rebuild an existing 35.5-mile-long transmission line between the Couderay Substation in Sawyer County and Osprey Substation in Rusk County to meet the area's growing electricity needs. The existing line was originally constructed in the 1950s. The proposed project also consists of replacing two-pole wood structures with single-pole steel structures.

Representatives from Xcel Energy will have detailed maps of the rebuild project and specific areas where additional right-of-way may be needed, as well as photographs of existing and proposed pole structures.
